In order to 25 comply with the Rehabilitation Act and its State Plan requirements, there is 26 hereby authorized for the Arkansas Rehabilitation Services a general waiver 27 of the Financial Management Guide, R1-19-4-522 Continuing Professional 28 Education. This waiver allows the agency to provide college level coursework 29 in degree programs for any eligible employees selected by the agency. This 30 provision covers any and all formula and discretionary grants funded by the 31 U.S.D.O.E. Rehabilitation Services Administration, now or in the future, 32 including, but not limited to, the Vocational Rehabilitation Program, 33 Supported Employment, Independent Living, and the Staff Development Grant. 34 The waiver applies to federal financial participation (FFP), state general 35 revenue share, and program income.

36 The provisions of this section shall be in effect from July 1, 2020 2021

1 through June 30, <del>2021</del> <u>2022</u>.

SECTION 14. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 3 4 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. COMPREHENSIVE SYSTEM OF PERSONNEL DEVELOPMENT. The Rehabilitation Act 5 6 Amendments of 1992, commonly referred to as the Comprehensive System of 7 Personnel Development (CSPD), requires State Vocational Rehabilitation (VR) 8 agencies to establish qualified personnel standards for rehabilitation 9 personnel, including Vocational Rehabilitation Counselors, that are 10 consistent with any national or State-approved or recognized certification, 11 licensing, or registration that apply to a particular profession. In order to 12 comply with the Rehabilitation Act and its State Plan requirements, there is hereby authorized for the Department of Commerce, Division of State Services 13 14 for the Blind a general waiver of the Financial Management Guide, R1-19-4-522 15 Continuing Professional Education. This waiver allows the agency to provide college level coursework in degree programs for any eligible employees 16 17 selected by the agency. This provision covers any and all formula and 18 discretionary grants funded by the U.S. Department of Education 19 Rehabilitation Services Administration, now or in the future, including, but 20 not limited to, the Vocational Rehabilitation Program, Supported Employment, 21 Independent Living, and the Staff Development Grant. No state general revenue 22 shall be expended for the tuition in pursuit of a degree authorized herein. 23 The provisions of this section shall be in effect from July 1, 2021 24 through June 30, 2022.

26 SECTION 15. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 27 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 28 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 29 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 30 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 31 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 32 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 33 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 34 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

SECTION 16. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General

Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. SECTION 17. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2021 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2021 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2021.
