## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING INDIVIDUALS LISTED
AS MANDATED REPORTERS UNDER THE CHILD MALTREATMENT ACT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 12-18-402(b)(22)-(26), concerning mandated reporters under the Child Maltreatment Act, are amended to read as follows:
(22)(A) A public or private school counselor A full-time or part-time employee of a public school, private school, or private or public institution of higher education, including without limitation:
(i) A school counselor;
(ii) A school official;
(iii) A teacher;
(iv) A coach or director of a public or private
athletic organization, team, or club; and
(v) A coach or director of a public or private
nonathletic organization, team, or club.
(B) Subdivision (b)(22)(A) of this section does not include an attorney employed by a public or private institution of higher education who obtains information concerning child maltreatment or suspected
