20	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-19-106 is amended to read as follows:	
23	6-19-106. Bus drivers — Qualifications.	
24	A person who has been convicted within the past three (3) years of	
25	operating a motor vehicle in a reckless manner or while under the influence	<u>e</u>
26	of intoxicating liquor or drugs or who is less than under nineteen (19) ye	ars
27	of age on June 30 following his or her last birthday shall not be permitte	d
28	or employed to operate $\frac{1}{2}$ a school bus, either privately or publicly owner	d,
29	operated by public school districts and used to transport pupils to and fr	om
30	the public schools in the State of Arkansas.

32	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 6-19-108(b)-(e), concerning the	
33	certification of bus drivers, are amended to read as follows:	
34	(b)(1) Upon successful completion and documentation of training lis	ted
35	the training described in subdivision (a)(2)(C) of this section, α	
36	certificate, valid for one (1) year, shall be issued by the division the

- 2 <u>certify the applicant as a school bus driver for a one-year period</u>.
- 3 (2) Certification as a school bus driver by the Division of
- 4 Public School Academic Facilities and Transportation may be renewed annually.
- 5 (c)(1) A school bus driver shall not be employed as an operator of a
- 6 school bus to transport children to and from school or school-sponsored
- 7 activities unless he or she is certified as a school bus driver by the
- 8 division and has satisfactorily completed the in-service training required in
- 9 subsection (d) of this section and possesses a current valid certificate
- 10 therefor.
- 11 (2) The certificate Certification as a bus driver by the
- 12 <u>Division of Public School Academic Facilities and Transportation</u> shall be
- 13 required in addition to a commercial driver's license and any additional

- 15 (d) A school bus driver who seeks a <u>annual</u> renewal of his or her bus
- 16 driver <u>certificate</u> <u>certification</u> shall provide proof that he or she has
- 17 satisfactorily:
- 18 (1) Passed a physical examination given by a licensed physician
- 19 or advanced practice nurse within the previous two (2) years; and
- 20 (2) Completed in-service training for school bus drivers as
- 21 prescribed by the division Division of Public School Academic Facilities and
- 22 Transportation.
- 23 (e) A school district board of directors may provide a substitute
- 24 driver to operate a school bus on a temporary basis without a certificate
- 25 <u>certification</u> until the next regularly scheduled school bus driver's
- 26 examination is held in the locality if:
- 27 (1) A qualified certified school bus driver is not available to
- 28 operate a the school bus due to death, resignation, disability, illness, or
- 29 other cause; and

- 31 obtain a qualified certified school bus driver with a certificate.
- 33 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 6-20-2507(b)(2)(B), concerning a school
- 34 district's application to participate in the Academic Facilities Partnership
- 35 Program and life cycle data, is amended to read as follows:
- 36 (B) The Division of Public School Academic Facilities and

4	SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 6-20-2507(c)(1)(G), concerning a school
5	district's application to participate in the Academic Facilities Partnership
6	Program and life cycle data, is amended to read as follows:
7	(G) Regularly scheduled and unscheduled maintenance,
8	repair, and renovation as documented in the Computerized Maintenance
9	Management System;

11	SECTION 5. Arkansas Code § 6-20-2507(c)(2)(G), concerning the Academic
12	Facilities Partnership Program and life cycle data, is amended to read as
13	follows:
14	(G) Regularly scheduled and unscheduled maintenance,
15	repair, and renovation <u>as documented in the Computerized Maintenance</u>
16	Management System;
17	
18	SECTION 6. Arkansas Code § 6-21-806(c), concerning schools districts
19	that participate in the Academic Facilities Master Plan Program and the
20	preliminary facilities master plan, is amended to read as follows:
21	(c) (1) The division shall establish procedures and timelines for a
22	school district to submit a preliminary facilities master plan or a master
23	plan outline to the division before the submission of the school district's
24	final facilities master plan.
25	(2) The preliminary facilities master plan or master plan
26	outline shall form the basis for a $\underline{\Lambda}$ consultation meeting between
27	representatives of the school district and members of the division $\underline{\text{to discuss}}$
28	the development of the school district's facilities master plan shall be held
29	upon request of the school district.
30	(3) As soon as practicable after submission of the preliminary
31	facilities master plan or master plan outline, the division shall hold the
32	consultation meeting with the school district to:
33	(A) Assure understanding of the general goals of this
34	subchapter and the criteria by which projects will be evaluated;
35	(B) Discuss ways the facilities master plan may be
36	structured to meet the goals of this subchapter:

1	(G) Assist sensor districts to prepare accurate budgets
2	and reasonable project schedules; and
3	(D) Provide for efficiency and productivity in the
4	approval process for local academic facilities projects and state financial
5	participation in local projects.

7	SECTION 7. Arkansas Code § 6-21-816(e)(1) and (2), concerning the sale
8	or lease of public school facilities and petitions submitted to the Division
9	of Public School Academic Facilities and Transportation for a waiver, are
10	amended to read as follows:
11	(e)(1) $\frac{(A)}{(A)}$ If the division receives a petition under subsection (d) of
12	this section, the division, within five (5) days after receiving the
13	petition, shall notify each eligible entity granted a charter under the
14	Arkansas Quality Charter Schools Act of 2013, § $6-23-101$ et seq., and \underline{each}
15	statewide organization representing charter schools in Arkansas by certified
16	mail this state of the petition by:-
17	(A) Posting the petition on the division's website; and
18	(B) The notice under subdivision (e)(1)(A) of this section
19	shall include a copy of the petition Sending a copy of the petition to each
20	eligible entity and statewide organization representing charter schools by
21	email.
22	(2) Not later than thirty (30) days after the division provides
23	the notification required under subdivision (e)(1) of this section an
24	eligible entity granted a charter under the Arkansas Quality Charter Schools
25	Act of 2013, § 6-23-101 et seq., or statewide organization representing
26	charter schools in Arkansas receives a notice described in subdivision
27	(e)(1)(A) of this section, the <u>an</u> eligible entity or <u>a</u> statewide organization
28	representing charter schools may submit to the division an objection in
29	writing to the petition.
