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(b)(1) Every state department, agency, board, commission, and institution of higher education, and every constitutional officer shall report to the Legislative Council on June 30 of each year regarding its efforts to achieve its equal employment hiring program goal. (2) However, the report required of any institution by  $\S$  6-63-103 may be used in lieu of the report required under this subsection and shall be filed as provided in this subsection. (c) The employee handbook or manual of every state department, agency, board, commission, and institution of higher education and every employee handbook or manual of every constitutional office shall include the following statement in describing the equal employment opportunity hiring program required under this section: "The State of Arkansas does not discriminate in access to employment opportunities or in employment or practices on the basis of race, color, religion, sex, national origin, age, disability, or genetic information."
