SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY FORWARD. At the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020 2021, any unexpended balance of monies provided from the State Library Fund Account for Books and Subscriptions, as provided in the State Operations Appropriation of this Act, shall be transferred forward and made available for the same purpose for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2021 2022.

Any carry forward of unexpended balance of funding as authorized herein, may be carried forward under the following conditions:

- (1) Prior to June 30, 2021 2022 the Agency shall by written statement set forth its reason(s) for the need to carry forward said funding to the Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget;
- (2) The Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget shall report to the Arkansas Legislative Council all amounts carried forward by the September Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee meeting which report shall include the name of the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution and the amount of the funding carried forward, the program name or line item, the funding source of that appropriation and a copy of the written request set forth in (1) above;
- (3) Each Agency, Board, Commission or Institution shall provide a written report to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee containing all information set forth in item (2) above, along with a written statement as to the current status of the project, contract, purpose etc. for which the carry forward was originally requested no later than thirty (30) days prior to the time the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution presents its budget request to the Arkansas Legislative Council/Joint Budget

- 1 Committee; and
- 2 (4) Thereupon, the Department of Finance and Administration shall
- 3 include all information obtained in item (3) above in the budget manuals
- 4 and/or a statement of non-compliance by the Agency, Board, Commission or
- 5 Institution.
- The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2020

- 9 SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 10 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
- 11 OF FUNDS PROMOTIONAL ITEMS. The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall
- 12 establish upon request from the Arkansas Department of Education Arkansas
- 13 State Library a special appropriation line item to be used in the acquisition
- 14 of promotional items. When the Department of Education Arkansas State
- 15 Library wishes to transfer monies from its operating expenses to promotional
- 16 items, the request shall be forwarded to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the
- 17 State for processing after prior approval by the Arkansas Legislative Council
- 18 or Joint Budget Committee. Determining the maximum number of employees and
- 19 the maximum amount of appropriation and general revenue funding for a state
- 20 agency each fiscal year is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is
- 21 usually accomplished by delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s)
- 22 for a state agency and the general revenue allocations authorized for each
- 23 fund and fund account by amendment to the Revenue Stabilization Law.
- 24 Further, the General Assembly has determined that the Department of Education
- 25 Arkansas State Library may operate more efficiently if some flexibility is
- 26 provided to the Department of Education Arkansas State Library authorizing
- 27 broad powers under this Section. Therefore, it is both necessary and
- 28 appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight by requiring prior
- 29 approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee as provided by
- 30 this Section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or
- 31 Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this Section. If the
- 32 requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee
- 33 is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, this entire
- 34 section is void.
- 35 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2020
- 36 <u>2021</u> through June 30, <del>2021</del> <u>2022</u>.

SECTION 11. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

SECTION 12. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

SECTION 13. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2021 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2021 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2021.
