1 Provided, however, that the Board shall be limited to submitting no more than 2 two requests, encompassing a single purpose listed in this section, during 3 any fiscal year per department. This is usually accomplished by 21 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and 22 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by 23 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. TRANSFER 35 AUTHORITY FOR UTILITY AND FUEL RATE INCREASE. In the event of a ten percent 36 (10%) increase in utility and fuel rates, the Department of <u>Corrections -</u>

Division of Community Correction is authorized to transfer from any line item in the State Operations Appropriation to the Operating Expense line item in the State Operations Appropriation for support of the increase after receiving approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State. Prior to the utilization of the transfer authority a report shall be made to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee including justification for the transfer and the amount of transfer.

8 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of 9 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year 10 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by 11 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and 12 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by 13 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly 14 has determined that the Department of Corrections - Division of Community 15 Correction may operate more efficiently if some flexibility is provided to 16 the Department of Corrections - Division of Community Correction authorizing 17 broad powers under this Section. Therefore, it is both necessary and 18 appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight by requiring prior 19 approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee as provided by 20 this section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or 21 Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section. If the 22 requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee 23 is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, this entire 24 section is void.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2020

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28 SECTION 16. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. COUNTY 29 30 JAIL INVOICE SUMMARY. The Department Divisions of Corrections and Department 31 of Community Correction, shall at a minimum and on a fiscal year basis, 32 prepare and post on the applicable agency web site, a monthly summary of 33 county jail reimbursement invoices prepared and forwarded to each county 34 sheriff for verification by the Departments and for payment from the County 35 Jail Reimbursement Fund. In addition, the report shall include a summary of 36 invoices returned by each county for payment for previous months within the

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1 fiscal year, the amounts paid, and any balances owed. Each fiscal year-end 2 report shall be maintained on the web sites for a period of no less than 3 three (3) years.

4 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2020
5 <u>2021</u> through June 30, 2021 <u>2022</u>.

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SECTION 17. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. MOTOR
VEHICLE PURCHASE PROVISION. The Department of <u>Corrections - Division of</u>
Community Correction is hereby authorized to purchase motor vehicles from the
appropriations authorized for Capital Outlay in the State Operations and
Special Revenue Operations appropriations in this Act.

13 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2020 14 <u>2021</u> through June 30, 2021 <u>2022</u>.

SECTION 18. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 16 17 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 18 PAROLE/PROBATION OFFICERS HIRING. The Department of Corrections - Division 19 of Community Correction shall report quarterly to the Arkansas Legislative 20 Council or Joint Budget Committee the number of vacant Parole/Probation 21 Officer, Parole/Probation Area Manager, Parole/Probation Assistant Area 22 Manager positions and average case load per Parole/Probation Officer. 23 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2020 24 2021 through June 30, 2021 2022.

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26 SECTION 19. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 27 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 28 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 29 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 30 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 31 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 32 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 33 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 34 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

SECTION 20. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General

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Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

9 SECTION 21. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the 10 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits 11 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2021 is essential to the operation of 12 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 13 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the 14 15 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2021 could work irreparable harm 16 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental 17 programs.
