18	18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE ST	ATE OF ARKANSAS:

20	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 22-3-1225 is	amended to read as follows:
21	22-3-1225. Prison Construction Trust Fund.	
22	22 (a)(1) The Arkansas Development Finance	Authority shall establish in
23	23 its records a trust fund to be entitled the "Pr	ison Construction Trust Fund".
24	24 <u>(2)</u> All moneys derived by or remit	ted to the Arkansas
25	Development Finance Authority, from the sale of	annual license plate
26	26 validation decals , pursuant to <u>under</u> § 27-14-10	15(c), shall be deposited to
27	27 the credit of the Prison Construction Trust Fun	d.
28	28 <u>(3)</u> The moneys in the Prison Const	ruction Trust Fund shall not
29	29 be general funds or revenues of the Arkansas De	velopment Finance Authority
30	and shall not be subject to the claims of the g	eneral creditors of the

32	32 (b)(1) The Arkansas Development Finance	Authority shall pay from the
33	Prison Construction Trust Fund into the Public	Facilities Debt Service Fund

35	other funds listed in $22-3-1210$, to pay the n	ext-succeeding principal and
36	36 interest payment for the certificates of indebt	edness, but not to exceed

- 1 twenty-five cents (25¢) times the number of annual license plate validation
- 2 decals sold by the Department of Finance and Administration in each six-month
- 3 period.
- 4 (2) Such payments shall be made by the Arkansas Development
- 5 Finance Authority semiannually two (2) business days prior to each July 1 and
- 6 January 1 so long as the certificates of indebtedness permitted by the Public
- 7 Facilities Finance Act of 1983, § 22-3-1201 et seq., are outstanding.
- 8 (3) All such payments by the Arkansas Development Finance
- 9 Authority to the Public Facilities Debt Service Fund shall cease when the
- 10 certificates of indebtedness have been paid or redeemed.
- 11 (c) All other funds in the Prison Construction Trust Fund shall be
- 12 segregated, held, and upon the review and approval of the Secretary of the
- 13 Department of Corrections and the Board of Corrections, used by the Arkansas
- 14 Development Finance Authority solely to fund, or to provide for the funding
- of, the construction and, purchasing, or equipping of:
- 16 (1) Correction or prison facilities to be used by the $\frac{\text{Division}}{\text{Division}}$
- 17 of Correction Department of Corrections;
- 18 (2) Regional jail facilities operated by the Division of
- 19 Correction Department of Corrections; or
- 20 (3) Regional jail facilities operated jointly by cities,
- 21 counties, or regional jail commissions.
- 22 (d) The Arkansas Development Finance Authority shall be authorized to
- 23 fund or to provide for the funding of facilities described in subdivisions
- 24 (c)(1)-(3) of this section by loans, leases, other contracts, or the issuance
- 25 of bonds all in accordance with the provisions of the Arkansas Development
- 26 Finance Authority Act, § 15-5-101 et seq., and §§ 15-5-201 15-5-211, 15-5-
- 27 213, and 15-5-301-15-5-316, and to pledge the cash funds collected by it
- 28 from the sale of annual license plate validation decals and deposited into
- 29 the Prison Construction Trust Fund, after payment of the amounts as specified
- 30 in subsection (b) of this section to the repayment of any loans, leases,
- 31 contracts, or bonds.
- 32 (e)(1) The Arkansas Development Finance Authority shall not fund or
- 33 provide for the funding of $\frac{any}{a}$ facility described in subsection (c) of this
- 34 section to be operated or utilized by the Division of Correction Department
- 35 of Corrections unless the project, the plans therefor, and the construction
- 36 thereof have been reviewed and approved by the Building Authority Division.

1	(2) The Arkansas Development Finance Authority shall not fund or	
2	provide for the funding of any other regional jail facility not utilized by	
3	the Division of Correction <u>Department of Corrections</u> unless the project is in	
4	compliance with the minimum standards for jail facilities adopted by the	
5	state.	
6		
7	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the	
8	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that overcrowding within the	
9	Division of Correction and increasing parole and probation caseloads within	
10	the Division of Community Correction are among the most pressing problems	
11	currently burdening the state both from a public safety and budgetary	
12	standpoint; that safe and effective measures are needed to immediately combat	
13	these problems; and that this act is immediately necessary and in the	
14	interest of public safety and the state budget of the Department of	
15	Corrections, the department should be allowed to immediately utilize the	
16	Prison Construction Trust Fund for the acquisition of existing facilities.	
17	Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this act being immediately	
18	necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall	
19	become effective on:	
20	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;	
21	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,	
22	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the	
23	bill; or	
24	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is	
25	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
