13	16-31-103. Exemptions from service.		
14	(a) Any person may be excused from serving as a grand or petit juror		
15	or a jury commissioner for such period as the court deems necessary or may		
16	have his <u>or her</u> service deferred to another specified term of court when the		
17	state of his $\underline{\text{or her}}$ health or that of his family reasonably requires his $\underline{\text{or}}$		
18	<u>her</u> absence, or when, for any reason, his own interests or those of the		
19	public will, in the opinion of the court, be materially injured by his		
20	attendance.		
21	(b) A person who is eighty (80) years of age or older may voluntarily		
22	exempt himself or herself from or decline to participate in jury service at		
23	any time.
