11	PROMOTIONAL ITEMS. The Arkansas State Police is hereby authorized to
12	purchase from Maintenance & General Operations Classifications in the
13	Operations Appropriation provided by this Act, up to an amount not to exceed
14	\$2,500 each fiscal year, promotional items, authorized by the Director
15	Secretary of the Department to meet requirements of the Arkansas State Police

22	OVERTIME. The Arkansas State Police is hereby authorized to make overtime
23	payments from such funds and appropriations provided for overtime payments to
24	those officers or other employees that are currently assigned or may be
25	assigned by the Director <u>Secretary</u> of the Department of Public Safety -
26	Division of Arkansas State Police to Special Law Enforcement Task Forces and
27	other special programs reimbursable to Arkansas State Police by federal or

The Arkansas State Police is hereby authorized to 4 purchase motor vehicles from the appropriations authorized for Capital Outlay 5 in the State Police Operations and/or Confiscated Funds Transfer 6 appropriation in this Act. Motor vehicles donated to Arkansas State Police 7 and confiscated vehicles used for Arkansas State Police operations shall not 8 be included in the maximum number of authorized passenger vehicles. 9 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2020 10 2021 through June 30, 2021 2022. 11 12 SECTION 40. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. ASP. 13 14 UNIFORM EMPLOYEE HEALTH INSURANCE PROGRAM REPORTING. The Arkansas State 15 Police shall report monthly to the Governor, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the 16 State and to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee 17 regarding the activity and condition for the uniformed employee health 18 insurance plan. The report shall include, but not limited to, the beginning 19 reserve fund balance, contributions made during the month, claims paid, and 20 the ending fund balance of the month. The Arkansas State Police is hereby authorized to 33 purchase from Maintenance & Operations Classifications in the Operations 34 Appropriation provided by this Act, up to an amount not to exceed two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500) each fiscal year, for emergency 35 36 purchases for food, drinks and other essential items during emergency

LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 10 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 11 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 12 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 13 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 14 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 15 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 16 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 17 18 SECTION 47. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the 19 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits 20 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2021 is essential to the operation of 21 22 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 23 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2021 could work irreparable harm 24 25 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental 26 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act 27 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2021. 28 29 30 31 32 33 34 35
