The Arkansas State Police is hereby authorized to purchase from Maintenance & General Operations Classifications in the Operations Appropriation provided by this Act, up to an amount not to exceed \$2,500 each fiscal year, promotional items, authorized by the Director Secretary of the Department to meet requirements of the Arkansas State Police Strategic Recruitment Plan.

34	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
35	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
36	effective date of this Act heyond July 1 2021 could work irrenarable harm

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     upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
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     programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
     being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
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     and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2021.
