- 16 payments shall be processed through the State Accounting System and shall be
- 17 in addition to the Regular Salaries and benefits accruing to the employee.

- The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2020
- 21 2021 through June 30, 2021 2022.

- 23 SECTION 41. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 24 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. ASP.
- 25 MOTOR VEHICLE PURCHASE. The Arkansas State Police is hereby authorized to
- 26 purchase motor vehicles from the appropriations authorized for Capital Outlay
- 27 in the State Police Operations and/or Confiscated Funds Transfer
- 28 appropriation in this Act. Motor vehicles donated to Arkansas State Police
- 29 and confiscated vehicles used for Arkansas State Police operations shall not
- 30 be included in the maximum number of authorized passenger vehicles.
- 31 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2020

- 3 regarding the activity and condition for the uniformed employee health

- 21 thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500) fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) each

- 32 QUARTERLY REPORTING. The Arkansas State Police shall on a quarterly basis
- 33 provide to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee a
- 34 report detailing expenditures from the Court Awards Fund of the Confiscated
- 35 Funds Transfer appropriation of this Act. The report shall include the State
- 36 Police division, purpose and amount of expenditures.

- 9 (a)(1)(A) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State may create paying accounts
- 10 on his or her books and on the books of the Treasurer of State and the
- 11 Auditor of State for the payment of personal services and operating expenses
- 12 by the Department of Public Safety.
- 13 (B) Upon prior approval of the Arkansas Legislative Council, or
- 14 if meeting in Legislative Session the Joint Budget Committee, the Chief

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- 22 SECTION 47. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
- 23 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
- 24 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
- 25 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
- 26 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
- 27 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
- 28 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
- 29 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
- 30 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

- 32 SECTION 48. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
- 33 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
- 34 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
- 35 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
- 36 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget

T	manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
2	summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
3	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

5	SECTION 49. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
6	General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
7	the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
8	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2021 is essential to the operation of
9	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
10	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
11	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2021 could work irreparable harm
12	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
13	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
14	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
15	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2021.
