1	(i) Work for the laboratory for a term that equals		
2	twenty-four (24) months for each year that the program makes a payment on the		
3	pathologist's student loan; and		
4	(ii) Reimburse the program if the pathologist		
5	resigns or is terminated for cause before the term of the employment contract		
6	terminates.		
7	(3) The amount of the payment to be made directly to the		
8	pathologist's student loan creditor shall not exceed:		
9	(A) Twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) per twenty-four		
10	months; or		
11	(B) One hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) per		
12	pathologist.
