23	SECTION 3. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED IN	TO THE ARKANSAS			
24	CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. <u>FUNDING</u>				
25	TRANSFER. (i) Immediately upon the effective date of this act, the Chief				
26	Fiscal Officer of the State shall transfer on his or her books and those of				
27	the State Treasurer and the Auditor of the State the sum of five hundred				
28	thousand dollars (\$506,750) from the General Revenue Allotment Reserve Fund				
29	to the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account to be used exclusively for				
30	personal services, operating expenses and grants for the Office of Deaf and				
31	Hearing Impaired.				
32	(ii) Funds transferred to the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account for the				
33	Office of Deaf and Hearing Impaired in subsection (i) herein shall be				
34	deposited into a sub-fund in the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account that				
35	shall be carried forward from year to year for the Office of Deaf and Hearing				
36	Impaired appropriations provided by the General Assembly.				

SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2021 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2021 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2021.
