8 AN ACT TO MODIFY PHYSICIAN DISPENSING; TO ALLOW  
9 DELEGATION OF PHYSICIAN DISPENSING; AND FOR OTHER  
10 PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

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14 TO MODIFY PHYSICIAN DISPENSING; AND TO  
15 ALLOW DELEGATION OF PHYSICIAN DISPENSING.  
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18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 17-95-102 is amended to read as follows:

21 17-95-102. ~~Legend~~ Physician dispensing of drugs in Schedules III-V.

22 (a) ~~A dispensing physician is~~ As used in this section, a "dispensing  
23 physician" means a physician licensed under the Arkansas Medical Practices  
24 Act, § 17-95-201 et seq., § 17-95-301 et seq., and § 17-95-401 et seq., who  
25 purchases ~~legend~~ drugs in Schedules III-V to be dispensed to his or her  
26 patients for the patients' personal use and administration outside the  
27 physician's office.

28 (b) This section ~~shall~~ does not apply to physicians who only dispense  
29 drugs in injectable form unless they are controlled substances, in which case  
30 the section shall fully apply.

31 (c) The dispensing physician shall:

32 (1) Personally dispense ~~legend~~ drugs in Schedules III-V, and the  
33 dispensing of ~~such~~ drugs in Schedules III-V may ~~not~~ be delegated;

34 (2)(A) Keep records of all receipts and distributions of ~~legend~~  
35 drugs in Schedules III-V.

36 (B) The records shall be subject to inspection by the



1 proper enforcement authority and shall be readily accessible for inspection  
2 and maintained in a central registry; and

3 (3) Label ~~legend~~ drugs in Schedules III-V with the following  
4 information:

5 (A) Patient's name and address;

6 (B) Prescribing physician's address and narcotic registry  
7 number issued by the United States Drug Enforcement Administration;

8 (C) Date of dispensing; and

9 (D) Directions and cautionary statements, if any, as  
10 required by law.

11 ~~(d)(1) A physician licensed under the Arkansas Medical Practices Act,~~  
12 ~~§ 17-95-201 et seq., § 17-95-301 et seq., and § 17-95-401 et seq., shall not~~  
13 ~~dispense legend drugs without prior approval by the Arkansas State Medical~~  
14 ~~Board after application to the board and on the showing of need.~~

15 ~~(2) Licensed physicians who were dispensing in the ordinary~~  
16 ~~course of their practice before April 12, 2013, shall be exempt from the~~  
17 ~~requirements of this subsection.~~

18 ~~(3) The board shall determine whether need exists for a~~  
19 ~~physician to dispense a specific legend drug to the physician's patient for a~~  
20 ~~patient's personal use and administration outside of the physician's office~~  
21 ~~based on such information as is necessary for the board to determine;~~

22 ~~(A) The legend drug or drugs that the physician requests~~  
23 ~~to dispense;~~

24 ~~(B) The ability of a physician's patient to obtain the~~  
25 ~~legend drug from other medical professionals;~~

26 ~~(C) The availability of the legend drug to be prescribed~~  
27 ~~by the physician;~~

28 ~~(D) The hours at which the legend drug may be obtained~~  
29 ~~from other medical professionals;~~

30 ~~(E) The distance the physician's patient must travel to~~  
31 ~~obtain the legend drug from other medical professionals;~~

32 ~~(F) Whether the physician has been investigated by the~~  
33 ~~board concerning the improper prescribing or use of a legend drug;~~

34 ~~(G) Whether the physician has a financial relationship~~  
35 ~~with the manufacturer of a legend drug that would create the appearance of a~~  
36 ~~conflict of interest;~~

1                   ~~(H) Whether the physician dispensing a legend drug will~~  
 2 ~~foster cost containment through improved efficiency and productivity; and~~

3                   ~~(I) The procedures the physician has implemented to:~~

4                   ~~(i) Assure compliance with the requirements of~~  
 5 ~~subsection (c) of this section;~~

6                   ~~(ii) Monitor and guard against potential drug~~  
 7 ~~interactions;~~

8                   ~~(iii) Store and safeguard the legend drugs; and~~

9                   ~~(iv) Comply with the Prescription Drug Monitoring~~  
 10 ~~Program Act, § 20-7-601 et seq., concerning the reporting requirements to the~~  
 11 ~~Prescription Drug Monitoring Program.~~

12                   ~~(4)(d)~~ A prescription for a topical medication, Naloxone,  
 13 nicotine replacement therapy products, or contraceptives is exempt from  
 14 ~~subdivision (d)(3) of this section.~~

15                   (e) The ~~board~~ Arkansas State Medical Board shall enforce the  
 16 provisions of this section and is authorized and directed to adopt rules to  
 17 carry out ~~its purpose~~ the purpose of this section.

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
