4	(ii) The committee shall divide equally and deposit

7	(C) Proof of successful completion of ten thousand four		
8	hundred (10,400) hours of practice under a collaborative practice agreement		
9	with a physician; and		
10	(D) Any other relevant information as determined by the		
11	committee.		
12	(2)(A) A certificate of full independent practice authority		
13	shall be renewed every two (2) years through an application process with an		
14	appropriate renewal fee as determined by the committee.		
15	(B) The committee shall divide equally and deposit the

18	(c)(1) A certified nurse practitioner with a certificate of full

22	(2) Full independent practice authority shall extend to drugs		
23	<u>listed in Schedules II - V.</u>		
24	(d)(1) The Full Independent Practice Committee is created within the		
25	Department of Health.		
26	(2) The committee shall consist of nine (9) members as follows:		
27	(A) For the first six (6) years:		
28	(i) Three (3) physicians who are appointed by the		
29	Arkansas State Medical Board;		
30	(ii) Three (3) certified nurse practitioners who are		
31	appointed by the Arkansas State Board of Nursing;		
32	(iii) One (1) pharmacist who is appointed by the		
33	Arkansas State Board of Pharmacy;		
34	(iv) The Director of the Arkansas State Medical		
35	Board as an ex officio nonvoting member; and		
36	(v) The Executive Director of the Arkansas State		

1	board of Nursing as an ex officio nonvoting member; and	
2	(B)(i) After the first six (6) years of the committee, the	
3	Governor shall appoint seven (7) certified nurse practitioners who have had a	
4	certificate of full independent practice authority issued in this state and	
5	are in good standing.	
6	(ii) The Director of the Arkansas State Medical	
7	Board and the Executive Director of the Arkansas State Board of Nursing shall	
8	serve as ex officio nonvoting members.	
9	(3)(A)(i) Committee members shall serve three-year terms.	
10	(ii) Committee members shall not serve more than two	
11	(2) consecutive terms.	
12	(B) A committee member shall serve until a successor is	
13	appointed by the appropriate appointing entity.	
14	(4)(A) The committee shall elect a chair with powers and duties	
15	determined by the committee.	
16	(B) The chair may be elected for no more than two (2)	
17	<pre>consecutive terms.</pre>	
18	(5)(A) A quorum of the committee shall be four (4) members.	
19	(B) The committee shall hold a meeting at least quarterly	
20	and at other times the committee considers advisable to perform the duties	
21	described in subsection (e) of this section.	
22	(6) The members of the committee shall receive mileage and per	
23	diem as is now provided to members of the appropriate appointing entity.	
24	(e) The committee shall:	
25	(1) Review and approve or deny all applications for a	
26	certificate of full independent practice authority for certified nurse	
27	practitioners and for renewal of a certificate of full independent practice	
28	authority for a certified nurse practitioner;	
29	(2) Review complaints made against certified nurse practitioners	
30	who has a certificate of full independent practice authority;	
31	(3)(A) Refer complaints to the Arkansas State Medical Board or	
32	the Arkansas State Board of Nursing, or both, as determined by the committee	
33	based on the complaint.	
34	(B) If the Arkansas State Medical Board or the Arkansas	
35	State Board of Nursing, or both, determine that the complaint is valid, the	
36	Arkansas State Medical Board or the Arkansas State Board of Nursing, or both.	

1	shall make recommendations to the committee;
2	(4) Review recommendations made by the Arkansas State Medical
3	Board or the Arkansas State Board of Nursing, or both, and notify the
4	certified nurse practitioner of any action taken by the committee based on
5	the recommendations; and
6	(5)(A) If the action taken is suspension or revocation of the
7	certificate of full independent practice authority, hold a hearing providing
8	the certified nurse practitioner who has a certificate of full independent
9	practice authority with ten (10) days' notice in writing to appear before the
10	committee, at the time and place as the committee may direct, to show cause
11	as to why his or her certificate of full independent practice authority
12	should not be suspended or revoked.
13	(B) At the hearing, the committee shall:
14	(i)(a) Have the power to subpoena witnesses.
15	(b) The chair of the committee or his or her
16	designee shall sign subpoenas and have the power to administer oaths;
17	(ii) Hear evidence; and
18	(iii)(a) Determine if the certificate of full
19	independent practice authority should be suspended or revoked.
20	(b) If the committee determines that the
21	certificate of full independent practice authority should be suspended or
22	revoked, the revocation shall take place immediately.
23	(C) However, only the Arkansas State Board of Nursing has
24	the authority to suspend or revoke the nursing license of a certified nurse
25	practitioner.
26	(f) A certified nurse practitioner whose certificate of full
27	independent practice authority has been denied, suspended, or revoked by the
28	committee under this section may appeal the action of the committee under the
29	Arkansas Administrative Procedure Act, § 25-15-201 et seq.
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
