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2 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 8-4-208(a), concerning the state water 3 pollution control agency, is amended to read as follows: 4 (a)(1) The Division of Environmental Quality is authorized, subject to 5 the approval of the Governor, to administer on behalf of the state its own 6 permit program for discharges into navigable waters within its jurisdiction 7 in lieu of that of the United States Environmental Protection Agency. The 8 division is also authorized to submit to the Administrator of the United 9 States Environmental Protection Agency for approval a full and complete 10 description of the program which the division proposes to establish and 11 administer under state law, as provided by § 402(b) of the Federal Water 12 Pollution Control Act Amendments of 1972, 33 U.S.C. § 1342(b). To that end, the division and the Arkansas Pollution Control and Ecology Commission are 13 14 vested with all necessary authority and power to meet the requirements of § 15 402(b) of the Federal Water Pollution Control Act Amendments of 1972, 33 16 U.S.C. § 1342(b), and the guidelines promulgated by the United States 17 Environmental Protection Agency pursuant to § 304(h)(2) of the Federal Water 18 Pollution Control Act Amendments of 1972, 33 U.S.C. § 1314(h), to engage in 19 an approved continuing planning process under § 303(e) of the Federal Water 20 Pollution Control Act Amendments of 1972, 33 U.S.C. § 1313(e), and to perform 21 any and all acts necessary to carry out the purposes and requirements of the 22 Federal Water Pollution Control Act Amendments of 1972 relating to this 23 state's participation in the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System 24 established under the Federal Water Pollution Control Act Amendments of 1972, 25 subject to all restrictions contained in the Federal Water Pollution Control 26 Act Amendments of 1972 and guidelines. 27 (2)(A) Subject to the approval of the Governor, the division may 28 administer on behalf of the state its own permit program for the dredge and 29 fill permitting program established in Section 404 of the Clean Water Act, as 30 amended, 33 U.S.C. § 1251 et seq. and regulations promulgated under Section 404 of the Clean Water Act, as amended, 33 U.S.C. § 1251 et seq. 31 32 (B) Any rule, standard, or other requirement adopted for 33 purposes of obtaining authorization for the permitting program under 34 subdivision (a)(2)(A) of this section may not become effective or otherwise enforceable until the United States Environmental Protection Agency has 35 36 approved the state's application for the state permit program for the dredge
