24	SECTION 1. Arka	nsas Code § 26-57-904(a), concerni	ng the tax rate under
25	the Arkansas Soft Drin	k Tax Act, is amended to read as fo	ollows:

13	twenty and six-tenths cents (20.6¢) the following tax for each gallon of soft		
14	drink $\frac{1}{2}$ which $\frac{1}{2}$ may be produced from each package or container by following		
15	the manufacturer's directions:		
16	(i) Twenty and six-tenths cents (20.6¢);		
17	(ii) Beginning January 1, 2023, fifteen and five-		
18	tenths cents (15.5¢); and		
19	(iii) Beginning January 1, 2024, seven and seven-		
20	tenths cents (7.7¢).		
21	(B) This tax applies when the sale of the powder or other		
22	base is sold to a retailer for sale to the ultimate consumer after the liquid		
23	soft drink is produced by the retailer.
