1	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the Arkansas Public Employees'		
2	Retirement System holds system funds in trust for the benefit of all members;		
3	that the Board of Trustees of the Arkansas Public Employees' Retirement		
4	System has a fiduciary duty to manage funds held in trust by the system,		
5	including the recoupment of debts to the system; that the law does not allow		
6	the system to waive debts or overpayments; that the system expends time and		
7	effort in the recoupment of debts and overpayment; that unrecovered debts or		
8	overpayments are ultimately borne by members of the system; that the system		
9	currently has recorded debts or overpayments that are in immediate need of		
10	collection; that time is of the essence in collecting debts or overpayments;		
11	that this act is of great importance to members of the system and to other		
12	citizens of this state in general; and that this act is immediately necessary		
13	in order to protect and maintain an orderly system of accounting for the		
14	members of the system. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this		
15	act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace,		
16	health, and safety shall become effective on:		
17	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;		
18	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,		
19	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the		
20	<u>bill; or</u>		
21	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is		
22	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
