25	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
26	
27	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 17-86-306(e), concerning massage therapy
28	schools, is amended to read as follows:
29	(e)(1) The department may certify the school and provide for licensure
30	thereof if the school follows a curriculum consisting of not fewer than five
31	hundred (500) hours of in-classroom instruction over a term of not fewer than
32	four (4) months consisting of the following subjects:
33	$\frac{(1)(A)}{(A)}$ One hundred seventy-five (175) hours of anatomy,
34	physiology, pathology, and contraindications to massage therapy;
35	$\frac{(2)(B)}{(B)}$ Two hundred twenty-five (225) hours of technique;
36	$\frac{(3)}{(C)}$ Twenty-five (25) hours of hydrotherapy, electrotherapy,

1	and heliotherapy;
2	(4)(D) Twenty-five (25) hours of hygiene and infection control;
3	$\frac{(5)}{(E)}$ Twenty-five (25) hours of massage therapy law, business
4	management, and professional ethics; and
5	$\frac{(6)}{(F)}$ Twenty-five (25) hours of related subjects as approved by
6	the department.
7	(2)(A) The curriculum established in subdivision (e)(1) of this
8	section may be completed through remote education in an online format and in-
9	person training with a master massage therapist or massage therapy instructor
10	in a licensed massage therapy clinic or massage therapy spa if the massage
11	therapy clinic or massage therapy spa has a collaborative agreement with a
12	massage therapy school.
13	(B) If a massage therapy clinic or massage therapy spa
14	cannot find a massage therapy school willing to enter into a collaborative
15	agreement with the massage therapy clinic or massage therapy spa, the massage
16	therapy clinic or massage therapy spa may apply to the department for an
17	exemption to the requirement in $(e)(2)(A)$ of this section.
