23	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-41-901 is amended to read as follows:			
24	6-41-901. Definitions - Establishment - Intent.			
25	(a) As used in this section subchapter:			
26	(1) <u>"Active duty member of the uniformed services" means a</u>			
27	person who is on full-time duty status in the active uniformed services of			
28	the United States, including without limitation a member of the National			
29	Guard and reserve components of the armed forces on active duty orders under			
30	10 U.S.C. §§ 1209 and 1210, as they existed on January 1, 2021;			
31	(2) "Foster care" means the care of a child by a group home or			
32	group facility on a twenty-four-hour-a-day basis away from the home of the

1 (3)(4) "Parent" means a student's parent or foster parent. 2 (b) The Succeed Scholarship Program is established and intended to 3 provide a scholarship to a private school of choice for: 4 (1) Students in foster care; or 5 (2) Students with disabilities who have either an: 6 (A) Individualized education program in accordance with 7 the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act, 20 U.S.C. § 1400 et seq.; or 8 (B) Individualized service plan in accordance with the 9 Individuals with Disabilities Education Act, 20 U.S.C. § 1412(a)(10); or (3) Students who are children of an active duty member of the 10 11 uniformed services. 12 13 SECTION 2.
