Arkansas Code § 26-18-303, as amended by Acts 2019, No. 4 866, § 3, and effective on and after May 1, 2021, concerning the 5 confidentiality and privileged nature of the records and files of the 6 Secretary of the Department of Finance and Administration, is amended to add 7 an additional subsection to read as follows: 8 (k)(1) The General Assembly finds that: 9 (A) The ability of the Bureau of Legislative Research to assist the General Assembly in state budgeting and forecasting matters is 10 important to the performance of the General Assembly's duties and the fiscal 11 12 soundness of the state; 13 (B) The General Assembly plays an essential role in determining the fiscal needs of the state, and the Bureau of Legislative 14 15 Research provides importance assistance to the General Assembly in its 16 performance of that role; 17 (C) To ensure the Bureau of Legislative Research can 18 provide accurate and complete information and analysis to the General 19 Assembly in order to assist the General Assembly in its duty to set state 20 appropriation amounts, it is essential that the Bureau of Legislative 21 Research have direct access to the tax records and other information that 22 would inform state budgeting and forecasting; and 23 (D) The sharing of documents and other information between 24 the Secretary of the Department of Finance and Administration and the Bureau 25 of Legislative Research will enable the General Assembly to better serve the 26 fiscal needs of the state. 27 (2) The Secretary of the Department of Finance and Administration shall provide the Bureau of Legislative Research with direct 28 access to all tax records and files in the custody of the Department of 29 30 Finance and Administration that are necessary for state budgeting, forecasting, and preparing fiscal impacts on proposed legislation. 31 32 (3)(A) The documents and other information that the Bureau of 33 Legislative Research has access to under this subsection shall not be 34 disclosed by the Bureau of Legislative Research to a person other than a 35 person specifically authorized by law to receive the documents or other 36 information.

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1	(B) The Bureau of Legislative Research may:		
2	(i) Disclose information in the same manner as		
3	provided in subdivisions (b)(1), (11), and (14) of this section;		
4	(ii)(a) Provide data from the documents and other		
5	information to which the Bureau of Legislative Research has access under this		
6	section to any consultant retained by the Bureau of Legislative Research in a		
7	form that does not allow the consultant to identify any individual taxpayer.		
8	(b) Any information obtained by a consultant		
9	retained by the Bureau of Legislative Research under this section shall be		
10	kept confidential and shall not be disclosed by the consultant; and		
11	(iii) Provide analysis of the documents and		
12	information to which it has access under this section to the General Assembly		
13	and any consultants retained by the Bureau of Legislative Research.		
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
