Arkansas Code § 8-7-1206(a)(5), concerning utilization of 2 the moneys within the Abandoned Agricultural Pesticide and Plant Regulator Disposal Trust Fund, is amended to read as follows: 3 4 (5) Moneys received into the fund shall be utilized by the State 5 Plant Board Department of Agriculture, as authorized by the Abandoned 6 Pesticide Advisory Board, to pay for projects and other activities relating 7 to the collection and disposal of abandoned pesticides and for administrative 8 support. 9 10 SECTION 3.
