6	the transportation of an intoxicated person to a sobering center is immune
7	from civil or criminal liability for any allegation resulting from the
8	transportation of the intoxicated person to the sobering center.
9	(f) A person detained for boating or driving while intoxicated, § 5-
10	$\underline{65-103}$, or for a felony offense is not eligible under this section to be
11	transported to a sobering center.
