14	(2) "Personal care services" includes:		
15	(A) Attendant care services; and		
16	(B) Respite care services.		
17	(c)(l) Personal care reimbursement rates shall be established at		
18	twelve dollars and thirty-five cents (\$12.35) per unit or at lesser amounts		
19	as may be established for a program of client-directed personal care which		
20	may be developed and implemented by the Department of Human Services If there		
21	is a change in the state or federal minimum wage, the Arkansas Medicaid		
22	Program shall conduct a review of the reimbursement rates for personal care		
23	services within ninety (90) days of the publishing of the rate by the		
24	Department of Labor and Licensing.		
25	(2) Within one hundred eighty (180) days of the review of the		
26	reimbursement rates under subdivision (c)(l) of this section, the Department		
27	of Human Services shall submit a state plan amendment, waiver, or other		
28	necessary authorization to modify the reimbursement rate of personal care		
29	services.		
30	(d) A reimbursement payment made under this section may not exceed the		
31	Medicaid upper payment limit as established by the Centers for Medicare $\&$		
32	Medicaid Services.		
33	(e) The program shall make sufficient funds available to a beneficiary		
34	to reimburse or pay a provider of personal care services for the number of		
35	hours of personal care services that the beneficiary needs or is qualified or		
36	eligible for, as determined by an independent assessment.
