17	adoption under § 25-15-204(f):		
18	(1) On or before November 1, 2021; or		
19	(2) If approval under § 10-3-309 has not occurred by November 1,		
20	2021, as soon as practicable after approval under § 10-3-309.		
21	(b) The commission shall file the proposed rules with the Legislative		
22	Council under § 10-3-309(c) sufficiently in advance of November 1, 2021, so		
23	that the Legislative Council may consider the rules for approval before		
24	<u>November 1, 2021.</u>
