27	SECTION 1. Arka	nsas Code § 7-4-109(a), concern	ing qualifications of
28	•	ssioners, election officials, p	
29	certified election monitors, is amended to add an additional subdivision to		
30	read as follows:		
31	<u>(4) A per</u>	son shall be eligible to serve	as an election official
32	if the person is marri	ed to or related within the sec	ond degree of

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2	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 7-5-101(a), concerning the establishment		
3	and alteration of precinct boundaries, polling sites, and vote centers, is		
4	amended to read as follows:		
5	(a)(1) The county board of election commissioners shall:		
6	(A) Establish election precincts; and		
7	(B)(i) Designate a polling site for each precinct.		
8	(ii) A polling site may serve two (2) or more		
9	precincts, including parts of precincts.		
10	(iii)(a) A polling site shall be established in all		
11	cities, municipalities, and towns of the state that require a polling site be		
12	established by ordinance.		
13	(b) Cities of the second class and		
14	incorporated towns shall provide a suitable facility for a polling site that		
15	meets all requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act, 42 U.S.C. §		
16	12101 et seq., and has adequate internet service available to execute the		
17	required activities of a polling site.		
18	(2) Except as provided in § 6-14-106, the designation of polling		
19	sites shall be by a unanimous vote of the members of the county board of		
20	election commissioners present.		
21	(3) If an existing polling site is closed by a majority vote of		
22	the county board of election commissioners, the closure shall be approved by		
23	State Board of Election Commissioners not less than sixty (60) days before an		
24	election except in the event of an emergency as determined by unanimous vote		
25	of the State Board of Election Commissioners.		
26			
27	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 7-5-107 is amended to read as follows:		
28	7-5-107. Use of voter registration lists by poll workers.		
29	(a)(1) In any election conducted in this state, precinct voter		
30	registration lists shall be used by poll workers in each polling place.		
31	(2)(A) An electronic poll book may be used by poll workers in		
32	each polling place.		
33	(B) The functions of an electronic poll book may include		
34	without limitation:		
35	(i) Voter lookup;		
36	(ii) Voter verification;		

1	(iii) Voter identification;		
2	(iv) Precinct assignment;		
3	(v) Ballot assignment;		
4	(vi) Recording when a voter presents himself or		
5	herself to an election official and requests a ballot; and		
6	(vii) Redirecting voters to the correct polling		
7	site; and		
8	(viii) Determining if a voter has requested an		
9	absentee ballot.		
10	(b) Precinct voter registration lists shall contain the name, address		
11	including zip code, and date of birth of each registered voter within the		
12	precinct, including those who have been designated inactive, the precinct		
13	number and county wherein the precinct is located, the name and date of the		
14	election, and a space for the voter's signature.		
15	(c) The following shall be printed at the top of each page of the		
16	precinct voter registration list:		
17	"IF YOU SIGN THIS FORM AND YOU ARE NOT A LAWFULLY REGISTERED VOTER $\overline{\text{OR}}$ IF YOU		
18	HAVE SUBMITTED AN ABSENTEE BALLOT FOR THIS ELECTION, YOU ARE MAKING A FALSE		
19	STATEMENT AND MAY BE COMMITTING PERJURY. PERJURY IS PUNISHABLE BY UP TO A		
20	\$10,000 FINE AND UP TO 10 YEARS IMPRISONMENT."		
21			
22	SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 7-5-305(a)(11), concerning requirements to		
23	vote and duties of poll workers, is amended to read as follows:		
24	(11)(A) Verify if a person requested an absentee ballot		
25	according to the precinct voter registration list; and		
26	(B) Permit the person to cast a provisional ballot if the		
27	person received an absentee ballot according to the precinct voter		
28	registration list.		
29			
30	SECTION 5. Arkansas Code § 7-5-418(c), concerning early voting		
31	procedures, is amended to add an additional subdivision to read as follows:		
32	(6)(A) Verify if a person requested an absentee ballot according		
33	to the precinct voter registration list; and		
34	(B) Permit a person to cast a provisional ballot if the		
35	person received an absentee ballot according to the precinct voter		
36	registration list.
