22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 5-1-102(13)(B)(i), concerning the
23 definition of "person" and its application in the Arkansas Criminal Code, is
24 amended to read as follows:

26 (B)(i)(a) As used in §§ 5-10-101 – 5-10-105 and 5-4-604,
27 “person” also includes an unborn child in utero at any stage of development.

29 (b) “Unborn child” means offspring of human
30 beings from conception until birth.
