Arkansas Code § 14-42-206(a), concerning nominating 20 petitions for municipal elections, is amended to read as follows: 21 (a)(1) The city or town council of any a city or town with the mayor-22 council form of government, may shall request the county party committees of 23 recognized political parties under the laws of the state to conduct party 24 primaries for municipal offices for the forthcoming year by resolution 25 passed: 26 (A) Before January 1 of the year of the election, if the 27 election will occur in a year in which the preferential primary election is 28 held in May under § 7-7-203; and 29 (B) No less than sixty (60) days before the party filing 30 period begins under § 7-7-203, if the election will occur in a year in which 31 the preferential primary election is held in March under § 7-7-203. 32 (2) The resolution shall remain in effect for the subsequent 33 elections unless revoked by the city or town council. 34 (3) When the resolution has been adopted, the clerk or recorder 35 shall mail a certified copy of the resolution to the chairs of the county 36 party committees and to the chairs of the state party committees.
