24	SECTION 1. DO 1	NOT CODIFY. <u>Temporary legislation</u> .	
25	(a) It is the	intent of the General Assembly to pro	otect high-risk
26	persons from potentia	l coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) exposur	e by granting
27	persons with a license	e to carry a concealed handgun a grac	<u>e period for</u>
28	license renewals that	would require in-person activities t	o complete the
29	renewal process.		
30	(b) A person wh	ho possesses or possessed a valid lic	ense to carry a
31	concealed handgun issu	ued by this state that expired on or	after March 17,
32	2020, and who is or was considered to be in a high-risk category as		
33	determined by the Department of Health as it pertains to coronavirus 2019		
34	(COVID-19) exposure may apply to the Division of Arkansas State Police for:		
35	<u>(1) An au</u>	utomatic reinstatement of his or her	license to carry a
36	concealed handgun if	the person's license to carry a conce	ealed handgun has

1	expired; or		
2	(2) An extension of time during which the license to carry a		
3	concealed handgun shall remain valid without a renewal.		
4	(c) A person who makes a request under subdivision (b)(l) of this		
5	section shall have his or her license to carry a concealed handgun renewed		
6	and considered valid for a period of up to eighteen (18) months as determined		
7	by the Director of the Division of Arkansas State Police.		
8	(d) A person who makes a request under subdivision (b)(2) of this act		
9	shall be granted a period of up to eighteen (18) months by the director to		
10	complete the in-person requirements of a license renewal.		
11	(e) During the time periods described under subsections (c) and (d) of		
12	this section, a license to carry a concealed handgun shall remain valid		
13	unless it is otherwise suspended or revoked by law.		
14			
15	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
16	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that certain persons are at a		
17	higher risk of coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) exposure or sickness due to the		
18	person's age, health conditions, or employment; that requiring a high risk		
19	person to attend to certain aspects of concealed handgun licensing renewal in		
20	person is not safe for either the licensee or any other person the licensee		
21	may come into contact with; and that this act is immediately necessary		
22	because a license to carry a concealed handgun provides safety and security		
23	to a licensee and requiring a licensee to renew in person ignores public		
24	health recommendations to avoid public interactions when possible. Therefore,		
25	an emergency is declared to exist, and this act being immediately necessary		
26	for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become		
27	effective on:		
28	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;		
29	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,		
30	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the		
31	bill; or		
32	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is		
33	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
