35 SECTION 2. <u>EMERGENCY CLAUSE</u>. It is found and determined by the 36 <u>General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the actions constituting</u>

a law enforcement officer or employee of a correctional facility.

limitation contact with the skin, a face covering, a glove, or the uniform of
