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12	SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 22-3-504(b), concerning requirements for
13	Capitol Arts and Grounds Commission project requests, is amended to read as
14	follows:
15	(b) The Capitol Arts and Grounds Commission may require that the
16	requests applications include:
17	(1) Architectural and landscaping plans, if appropriate, for the
18	project; <u>and</u>
19	(2) Sufficient information to demonstrate compliance with
20	applicable standards for development ; and
21	(3) Sufficient information to demonstrate consistency of the
22	project with zoning rules of the Capitol Zoning District Commission.
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
