#### Abstract

AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW REGARDING THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ON SUNDAY; TO ALLOW THE GOVERNING BODY OF A CITY OR COUNTY TO CALL A REFERENDUM ELECTION FOR THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ON SUNDAY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.


#### Abstract

Subtitle TO AMEND THE LAW REGARDING THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ON SUNDAY; AND TO ALLOW THE GOVERNING BODY OF A CITY OR COUNTY TO CALL A REFERENDUM ELECTION FOR THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ON SUNDAY.


BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 3-3-210(b)(1)(A)(i) and (ii), concerning the calling of a referendum election within a city or county for the sale of alcoholic beverages on Sunday, are amended to read as follows:
(i) A referendum election may be called in a city by a petition filed with the city clerk signed by fifteen percent (15\%) of the qualified electors who cast a vote in the city for the Office of Governor in the last general election in which the office appeared on the ballot or by a resolution adopted by a majority vote of the governing body of the city; or
(ii) A referendum election may be called in a county by a petition filed with the county clerk signed by fifteen percent (15\%) of the qualified electors who cast a vote in the county for the Office of

Governor in the last general election in which the office appeared on the ballot or by a resolution adopted by a majority vote of the quorum court.
