I	timely access to quality health care, social and psychological care from
2	cancer prevention screening services or early detection services, cancer
3	treatment, and follow-up care for survivors of cancer, through culturally
4	sensitive care coordination and support that includes:
5	(A) Acting as contacts for individuals within a health
6	disparity population who are found to have a symptom, physical sign, abnormal
7	clinical finding, or diagnosis of cancer following a screening or early
8	detection service, including without limitation the assistance in the
9	coordination of healthcare services and healthcare provider referrals;
10	(B) Facilitating the involvement of community and service
11	organizations to help individuals within a health disparity population who
12	are at risk for or who have cancer or caregivers of individuals within a
13	health disparity population who are at risk or who have cancer, or both to
14	overcome barriers, which may include lack of social support, financial, or
15	access to transportation, or difficulty in scheduling of healthcare
16	appointments to accessing quality and timely healthcare services;
17	(C) Notifying individuals within a health disparity
18	population of clinical trials and, if requested, facilitating enrollment in
19	the clinical trials;
20	(D) Anticipating, identifying, and helping patients
21	overcome barriers within the healthcare system to ensure prompt diagnostic
22	and treatment resolution of an abnormal finding of cancer;
23	(E) Coordinating with a relevant health insurance
24	ombudsman program to provide information about health coverage to individuals
25	within a health disparity population who are at risk for or who have cancer,
26	including without limitation information about private insurance, healthcare
27	savings accounts, the Arkansas Medicaid Program, and other publicly funded
28	programs; and
29	(F) Conducting ongoing outreach to health disparity
30	populations.
31	(b) The Winthrop P. Rockefeller Cancer Institute at the University of
32	Arkansas for Medical Sciences may establish a comprehensive cancer patient
33	navigation program to:
34	(1) Guide patients who are at risk for or who are diagnosed with
35	cancer through the healthcare system;
36	(2) Help patients who are at risk for or who are diagnosed with

1	cancer overcome physical, emotional, social, and financial barriers to
2	receiving timely and effective cancer treatment;
3	(3) Improve care of patients who are at risk for or who are
4	diagnosed with cancer in this state; and
5	(4) Establish a billing code for patient navigation
6	reimbursement.
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
