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17	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
18	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that this act is essential to the		
19	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety and to the operation of		
20	the alcohol laws in the State of Arkansas; that this act eliminates		
21	conflicting language and allows consistent application of alcohol laws; that		
22	this act is immediately necessary due to the substantial growth and continued		
23	expansion of the distilling industry in Arkansas; that clear and consistent		
24	application of the law to the distilling industry is in the public's		
25	immediate interest as is controlling the distribution of alcoholic beverages		
26	within the state. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this act		
27	being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health,		
28	and safety shall become effective on:		
29	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;		
30	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,		
31	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the		
32	bill; or		
33	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is		
34	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.		
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
