3	(b) By January 1, 2022, the director shall adopt and implement

5	(1) To prevent and detect fraud in the unemployment insurance	
6	program to prevent the payment of unemployment insurance program benefits to:	
7	(A) An incarcerated individual; and	
8	(B) An individual who is listed on state and national new	
9	hire databases as currently employed and ineligible for unemployment	
10	insurance program benefits; and	
11	(2) To engage with and routinely utilize the integrity data hub,	
12	administered by the National Association of State Workforce Agencies, or a	
13	similar program, to prevent and detect fraud in the unemployment insurance

16	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 11-10-706(f)(2), concerning the	
17	calculations for the unemployment stabilization tax for wages collected	
18	between July 1, 2007, through June 30, 2023, is amended to add an additional	
19	subdivision to read as follows:	
20	(C)(i) However, after collection of the proceeds of the	
21	stabilization tax specified in subdivisions $(f)(2)(A)$ and $(B)$ of this	
22	section, the proceeds of the stabilization tax in an additional amount of	
23	fifteen-hundredths of one percent (0.15%) of taxable wages collected during	
24	the period April 1, 2021, through December 31, 2023, shall be deposited and	
25	credited to the Division of Workforce Services Unemployment Insurance	
26	Administration Fund, there to be used solely for the purpose of modernizing	
27	information technology systems and hardware utilized in the administration of	
28	the unemployment insurance program.	
29	(ii) The aggregate amount to be transferred into the	
30	Division of Workforce Services Unemployment Insurance Administration Fund	
31	under this subdivision (f)(2)(C) shall not exceed thirty-five million dollars	
32	(\$35,000,000) and shall be reduced by the amount, if any, received from the	
33	United States Government for the purpose of modernizing information	
34	technology systems and hardware utilized in the administration of the	
35	<u>unemployment insurance program.</u>

1 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 19-5-1232(b)(2), concerning the use of the 2 Division of Workforce Services Unemployment Insurance Administration Fund, is amended to read as follows: 3 4 (2) The fund shall be used for personal services and operating 5 expenses of the unemployment insurance program necessary to the proper 6 administration of the Division of Workforce Services Law, § 11-10-101 et 7 seq., including expenses for modernizing information technology systems and 8 hardware utilized in the administration of the unemployment insurance 9 program, as determined by the Director of the Division of Workforce Services. 10 11 SECTION 4. DO NOT CODIFY. Report. 12 By December 31, 2023, the Director of the Division of Workforce Services shall submit a report to the Legislative Council describing the 13 impact of fraud on the unemployment insurance program and the efforts of the 14 15 Division of Workforce Services to prevent and detect fraud and recover 16 improper payments. 17 Retroactivity. The effective date of this 18 SECTION 5. DO NOT CODIFY. 19 act is retroactive to April 1, 2021. 20 SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the 21 22 General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that there is an urgent need to 23 update and modernize the information technology systems for administering 24 unemployment insurance claims and to create and apply an overpayment 25 prevention and recovery process due to a rise in unemployment insurance fraud 26 claims; that to combat unemployment insurance fraud claims, the Division of 27 Workforce Services will modernize its systems and create and apply an overpayment prevention and recovery process to prevent, detect, and recover 28 29 unemployment insurance fraud; and that this act is necessary because a 30 failure of the system could deprive Arkansans of the necessary resources to preserve their health and well-being. Therefore, an emergency is declared to 31 32 exist, and this act being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, 33 health, and safety shall become effective on April 1, 2021. 34 35 36
