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Services that an individual has refused an offer of suitable work, which 1 2 shall be reviewed by the director or his or her designee for a determination 3 as to continued eligibility for benefits. 4 (b) By January 1, 2022, the director shall adopt and implement 5 internal administrative policies and business processes: 6 (1) To prevent and detect fraud in the unemployment insurance 7 program to prevent the payment of unemployment insurance program benefits to: 8 (A) An incarcerated individual; and 9 (B) An individual who is listed on state and national new 10 hire databases as currently employed and ineligible for unemployment 11 insurance program benefits; and 12 (2) To engage with and routinely utilize the integrity data hub, 13 administered by the National Association of State Workforce Agencies, or a 14 similar program, to prevent and detect fraud in the unemployment insurance 15 program. 16 17 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 11-10-706(f)(2), concerning the 18 calculations for the unemployment stabilization tax for wages collected 19 between July 1, 2007, through June 30, 2023, is amended to add an additional 20 subdivision to read as follows: 21 (C)(i) However, after collection of the proceeds of the 22 stabilization tax specified in subdivisions (f)(2)(A) and (B) of this 23 section, the proceeds of the stabilization tax in an additional amount of fifteen-hundredths of one percent (0.15%) of taxable wages collected during 24 the period April 1, 2021, through December 31, 2023, shall be deposited and 25 credited to the Division of Workforce Services Unemployment Insurance 26 27 Administration Fund, there to be used solely for the purpose of modernizing information technology systems and hardware utilized in the administration of 28 29 the unemployment insurance program. 30 (ii) The aggregate amount to be transferred into the 31 Division of Workforce Services Unemployment Insurance Administration Fund under this subdivision (f)(2)(C) shall not exceed thirty-five million dollars 32 (\$35,000,000) and shall be reduced by the amount, if any, received from the 33 34 United States Government for the purpose of modernizing information technology systems and hardware utilized in the administration of the 35 36 unemployment insurance program.

13	By December 31, 2023, the Director of the Division of Workforce

16	Division of Workforce Services to prevent and detect fraud and recover	
17	<pre>improper payments.</pre>	
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19	SECTION 5. DO NOT CODIFY. Retroactivity. The effective date of this	
20	act is retroactive to April 1, 2021.	
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22	SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the	
23	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that there is an urgent need to	
24	update and modernize the information technology systems for administering	
25	unemployment insurance claims and to create and apply an overpayment	
26	prevention and recovery process due to a rise in unemployment insurance fraud	
27	claims; that to combat unemployment insurance fraud claims, the Division of	
28	Workforce Services will modernize its systems and create and apply an	
29	overpayment prevention and recovery process to prevent, detect, and recover	
30	unemployment insurance fraud; and that this act is necessary because a	
31	failure of the system could deprive Arkansans of the necessary resources to	
32	preserve their health and well-being. Therefore, an emergency is declared to	
33	exist, and this act being necessary for the preservation of the public peace,	
34	health, and safety shall become effective on April 1, 2021.
