11	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
12	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the ongoing public health		
13	emergency has increased the strain on the state's public health system and		
14	resources; that the shortage of nurses with a Bachelor of Science in Nursing		
15	degree has been emphasized by the ongoing public health emergency; that there		
16	are additional high-demand career fields that have been highlighted by the		
17	ongoing public health emergency; and that this act is immediately necessary		
18	in order to create accelerated, streamlined, and more affordable		
19	opportunities by which those choosing health care, nursing, and other high-		
20	demand career fields as their vocation may obtain advanced degrees to enter		
21	the high-need workforce earlier and at less cost. Therefore, an emergency is		
22	declared to exist, and this act being immediately necessary for the		
23	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective		
24	on:		
25	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;		
26	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,		
27	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the		
28	bill; or		
29	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is		
30	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
