24	SECTION 1. Ark	ansas Code § 27-52-111 is amended to re	ead as follows:

28	(a) As used in	this section:	
29	(1) "Aut	omated enforcement device" means a syst	tem operated by a
30	municipality or a dep	artment of state government that is ope	erating within the
31	boundaries of the mun	icipality that:	
32	(A)	Uses a photo-radar device that is cap	pable of detecting
33	a speeding violation_	or a violation of an official traffic o	control device or
34	official traffic control signal; and		
35	(B)	Photographs or records an image of th	ne vehicle used in
36	committing the violat	ion, the operator of the vehicle, or the	he license plate

1	of the vehicle; and
2	(2) "Municipality" means a city of the first class, a city of
3	the second class, or an incorporated town;
4	(3) "Official traffic control device" means a sign, signal,
5	marking, or device placed or erected by authority of a public body or
6	official having jurisdiction for the purpose of regulating, warning, or
7	guiding traffic; and
8	(4) "Official traffic control signal" means any device, whether
9	manually, electrically, or mechanically operated, by which traffic is
10	alternately directed to stop and to proceed.
11	(b) Except as used under subsection (c) of this section, an automated
12	enforcement device shall not be used by a law enforcement agency of a
13	municipality or a department of state government that is operating within the
14	boundaries of the municipality to detect or enforce:
15	(1) A violation of the traffic laws, rules, or regulations of
16	the State of Arkansas; or
17	(2) An ordinance of the municipality.
18	$\frac{(e)(1)(b)}{(b)}$ A municipality or a department of state government that is
19	operating within the boundaries of the municipality may use an automated
20	enforcement device to detect and enforce a violation of traffic laws or
21	ordinances:
22	(Λ) In a school zone; or
23	(B) At a railroad crossing.
24	(2) If a municipality or a department of state government that
25	is operating within the boundaries of the municipality uses an automated
26	enforcement device, then a certified law enforcement officer must:
27	(A) Be present with the automated enforcement device; and
28	(B) Issue the citation to the violator at the time and
29	place of the violation.
30	(c) Upon conviction for a traffic violation detected solely by an
31	automated enforcement device, the penalty imposed:
32	(1) May include any fine authorized by law for the specific
33	traffic violation; and
34	(2) Shall not include or result in the assessment of points
35	against a driver's license to operate a motor vehicle.
36	(d) This section shall not prevent the Arkansas Highway Police
