23	(b) The task force shall consist of	the following members:

26	(2) One (1) school nurse, appo	inted by the Governor;

1	(9) One (1) member appointed by the Governor from the state at

6	(11) Four (4) members appointed by the President Pro Tempore of	
7	the Senate from the state at large to assist in carrying out the purpose of

9	(12) The Chair of the House Committee on Aging, Children and	
10	Youth, Legislative and Military Affairs or his or her designee; and	
11	(13) The Chair of the Senate Interim Committee on Children and

13	(c) If a vacancy occurs on the task force, the vacancy shall be filled	
14	by the same process as the original appointment.	
15	(d)(1) Members of the task force shall not be compensated for their	
16	service on the task force.	
17	(2)(A) The Governor shall designate a member of the task force	
18	to serve as the chair.	
19	(B) The chair shall call the first meeting of the task	
20	force within ninety (90) days of the effective date of this act.	
21	(3)(A) The task force may meet using a digital platform.	
22	(B) The task force shall meet at least six (6) times, but	
23	the task force may hold additional meetings at the call of the chair.	
24	(4) The task force shall establish rules and procedures for	
25	conducting the business of the task force.	
26	(5)(A) Ten (10) members of the task force shall constitute a	
27	quorum for transacting business of the task force.	
28	(B) An affirmative vote of a majority of the members

31	(6) The commission shall provide staff, meeting space, and

33	(e)(l) The purpose of the task force is to take a systematic and	
34	holistic approach to eliminating child abuse in the state.	
35	(2) To achieve the purpose stated in subdivision (e)(1) of this	
36	section, the task force shall:	

1	(A) Study child abuse data in the state and the state's	
2	options for adopting or revising policies, procedures, programs, and services	
3	to assist in identifying and eliminating child abuse;	
4	(B) Recommend programs and services aimed at identifying	
5	and eliminating child abuse in the state; and	
6	(C) Develop policy recommendations, systematic	
7	recommendations, and recommendations regarding educational materials to help	
8	the state:	
9	(i) Identify children who are being abused; and	
10	(ii) Eliminate child abuse in the state.	
11	(f) On or before July 1, 2022, the task force shall file with the	
12	House Committee on Aging, Children and Youth, Legislative and Military	
13	Affairs and the Senate Interim Committee on Children and Youth a final	
14	written report of the task force's activities, findings, and recommendations.	
15	(g) The task force shall expire on December 31, 2022.	
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
