1	(b) Notwithstanding the provisions of any law or regulation to the
2	contrary, in order to improve the timeliness of benefit deliveries,
3	operational efficiencies, and cost savings and to minimize fraud, the
4	Department of Human Services and the Division of Workforce Services may
5	participate in a no-cost pilot program in which real-time employment and
6	income data is obtained from a payroll data provider that is a consumer
7	reporting agency for the purpose of assisting with the determination of an
8	individual's eligibility to receive the following benefits:
9	(1) Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program;
10	(2) Temporary Assistance for Needy Families; and
11	(3) Unemployment.
12	(c) The real-time employment and income data obtained under subsection
13	(b) of this section may also be used to conduct an analysis on the pilot
14	program.
15	(d) Should the pilot program successfully demonstrate cost savings,
16	the department and the division may incorporate the real-time employment and
17	income data into the eligibility verification determination processes.
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
