9	Arkansas for Medical Sciences shall be appointed as a member and chair of the		
10	board by the Governor and subject to confirmation by the Senate.		
11	(5) Two (2) members shall be duly qualified, licensed, and		
12	active medical practitioners and appointed by the Governor after consulting		
13	with the Arkansas Medical Society, Inc., and subject to confirmation by the		
14	Senate.		
15	(6) One (1) member shall be a licensed practicing physician in		
16	this state and shall be appointed by the Governor after consulting with the		
17	Physician's Section of the Arkansas Medical, Dental, and Pharmaceutical		
18	Association, Inc., and subject to confirmation by the Senate.		
19	(7) Two (2) members shall be appointed by the Governor after		
20	consulting with the Dean of the College of Medicine of the University of		
21	Arkansas for Medical Sciences and subject to confirmation by the Senate.		
22	(8) One (1) member shall be appointed by the Governor after		
23	consulting with the Arkansas Rural Health Partnership and subject to		
24	confirmation by the Senate.		
25	(9) One (1) member shall be appointed by the Governor after		
26	consulting with the Arkansas Hospital Association, Inc., and subject to		
27	confirmation by the Senate.		
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29	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 6-81-708(c)(4)(D), concerning the loan		
30	contracts, obligations, and conditions of rural medical practice loans, is		
31	repealed.		
32	(D) In the event of the death of the recipient, the entire loan		
33	amount that has not been converted to a scholarship grant pursuant to the		
34	terms of the loan contract shall be due and payable;		
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
