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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 7-2-102 is amended to read as follows:

23 7-2-102. First Congressional District.

24 (a) The First Congressional District shall be composed of:

 22 Miller, Montgomery, Nevada, Newton, Ouachita, Pike, Pope, Scott,  
 23 Sevier, Union, and Yell;

4           (b) The qualified electors residing in the counties and portions of  
 5 ~~Crawford County, Jefferson County, Newton County, Pulaski County~~ and  
 6 Sebastian County listed under subsection (a) of this section shall elect one  
 7 (1) member of the United States House of Representatives.

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 9           SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the  
 10 General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the General Assembly is  
 11 responsible for establishing the four (4) United States Congressional  
 12 Districts in the state; that the four (4) United States Congressional  
 13 Districts are based on the information provided by the federal decennial  
 14 census by the United States Bureau of the Census; that the federal decennial  
 15 census data delivery was delayed; that the establishment of the four (4)  
 16 United States Congressional Districts is necessary to provide equal  
 17 representation of the citizens of Arkansas in the United States Congress; and  
 18 that this act is immediately necessary because the establishment of the four  
 19 (4) United States Congressional Districts must occur in adequate time for the  
 20 candidates to file for office and for the citizens of Arkansas to have a fair  
 21 election. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this act being  
 22 immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and  
 23 safety shall become effective on:

24                   (1) The date of its approval by the Governor;

25                   (2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,  
 26 the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the  
 27 bill; or

28                   (3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is  
 29 overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
