26	SECTION 1. Arkansas	Code § 24-5-118(a)(2)(A)(	ii), concerning benefits
27	and annuity options under	the Arkansas State Highway	Employees' Retirement
28	System, is amended to read	as follows:	
29	(i	i) Upon the retirant's dea	ath, one-half $(\frac{1}{2})$ of the
30	reduced annuity to which t	the retirant would have been	n entitled, if living,
31	shall be paid to the survi	ving beneficiary for the re	emainder of his or her
32	life, if the beneficiary was either the retirant's spouse for at least $\frac{two}{v}$		
33	(2) years one (1) year immediately preceding the first payment due date of		
34	the retired member's annui	ty or another person age fo	orty (40) or older on the
35	first payment due date rec	eeiving more than one-half	$(\frac{1}{2})$ of his or her support

3	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
4	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that certain provisions of the law		
5	applicable to the Arkansas State Highway Employees' Retirement System are in		
6	urgent need of revision to bring the operations of the system into		
7	conformance with sound public pension policy; that amendments to the law in		
8	this act are of great importance to the citizens of this state; and that this		
9	act is necessary to maintain an orderly system of benefits for the members of		
10	the system. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this act being		
11	necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall		
12	become effective on July 1, 2021.
