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27	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-15-1505 is amended to read as follows:
28	6-15-1505. School district implementation.
29	(a) <del>Beginning with the 2003-2004 school year, each</del> <u>Each</u> local school
30	district shall establish procedures and monitoring processes to ensure that
31	the content of each course offered by the school district is consistent with
32	content standards and curriculum frameworks <del>developed</del> <u>approved</u> by the State
33	Board of Education.
34	(b) The superintendent of each school district shall provide to the
35	Division of Elementary and Secondary Education, by October 1 of each year
36	following the adoption of the plan under subsection (a) of this section, a



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1 written statement of assurance that the content of each class and subject 2 area, as required by the Standards for Accreditation of Arkansas Public 3 Schools and School Districts regardless of levels, is aligned to content 4 standards and curriculum frameworks developed approved by the state board in 5 the plan. 6 The division shall monitor, during the standards review visit, (c) 7 documentation of procedures and monitoring processes as required under 8 subsection (a) of this section related to the plan. 9 (d) If the division determines that a school district has failed to 10 align the content of each class and subject area as required by the state 11 board to content standards and curriculum frameworks developed approved by 12 the state board, the division shall take enforcement actions as outlined in 13 the Standards for Accreditation of Arkansas Public Schools and School 14 Districts: 15 (1) Note the failure to comply in the annual school performance 16 report under § 6-15-1402; and 17 (2) Cite the failure to comply of each school on the Standards 18 for Accreditation of Arkansas Public Schools and School Districts Annual 19 Report. 20 21 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 6-15-2907(h), concerning the statewide 22 student assessment system, is amended to read as follows: 23 (h) The division shall provide for statewide student assessments that 24 are: 25 (1) Valid and reliable; 26 (2) Obtained or developed, as appropriate, through contracts and 27 project agreements; 28 (3) Aligned to the Arkansas academic standards; and 29 (4) Scored and returned for public school and school district use by July 1 August 1 of each year. 30 31 32 33 34 35 36

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
