- 13 SECTION 51. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 14 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY
- 15 FORWARD MILITARY AFFAIRS GRANT PROGRAM. Any unexpended balance of funds
- 16 allocated for the Military Affairs Grant Program in the Arkansas Economic
- 17 Development Commission Fund Account which remain at the close of each state
- 18 fiscal year shall be carried forward to the next state fiscal year to be used

- 10 SECTION 52. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 11 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SHARED
- 12 SERVICES.
- 13 (a)(1)(A) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State may create paying
- 14 accounts on his or her books and on the books of the Treasurer of State and
- 15 the Auditor of State for the payment of personal services and operating
- 16 expenses by the Department of Commerce.
- 17 (B) Upon prior approval of the Arkansas Legislative Council, or
- 18 if meeting in Legislative Session the Joint Budget Committee, the Chief
- 19 Fiscal Officer of the State shall direct the transfer of funds and
- 20 appropriations to the Shared Services Paying Account appropriation section of
- 21 this act and the transfer of positions to the Regular Salaries Shared

COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 8 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 9 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 10 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 11 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 12 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 13 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 14 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 15 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 16 17 SECTION 55. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 18 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 19 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 20 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 21 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 22 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 23 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 24 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 25 26 SECTION 56. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the 27 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits 28 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2021 is essential to the operation of 29 30 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the 31 32 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2021 could work irreparable harm 33 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental 34 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act 35 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health

and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2021.
