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26	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-82-302(6), concerning the definition of		
27	"extraordinary academic ability" under the Arkansas Governor's Scholars		
28	Program, is amended to read as follows:		
29	(6)(A) "Extraor	dinary academic ability" means:	
30		(i) Achievement of a score <u>s</u>	uperscore, as defined by
31	§ 6-85-204(25), of 32 or above on the ACT or <u>a score of</u> 1410 or above on the		
32	SAT; and		
33		(ii) <u>Either:</u>	
34	(ii)(a) For students graduating from high		
35	school after December 31, 2001, achievement of a high school grade point		
36	average of 3.5 or abov	e on a 4.0 scale; or	

1	(b) Selection as a limited in either the		
2	National Merit Scholarship competition, the National Hispanic Recognition		
3	Program, or the National Achievement Scholarship competition conducted by the		
4	National Merit Scholarship Corporation.		
5	(B) For students graduating after December 31, 2001, the		
6	ACT scores superscores and SAT scores shall be earned by December 31 prior to		
7	the application deadline in order for the scores to be considered by the		
8	Division of Higher Education for a scholarship award;		
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10	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 6-82-1503(c), concerning the selection		
11	criteria under the Critical Needs Minority Teacher Scholarship Program, is		
12	amended to read as follows:		
13	(c)(l) The university is authorized to develop selection criteria		
14	through Critical Needs Minority Teacher Scholarship Program rules, which		
15	combine an applicant's ACT superscore, as defined by § 6-85-204(25), or ACT		
16	equivalent score and grade point average in the core curriculum into a		
17	selection index.		
18	(2) Notwithstanding the provisions of subdivisions (b)(1) and		
19	(b)(2) of this section, this selection index shall be employed as an		
20	alternative selection process for applicants who achieve a grade point		
21	average below 2.5 on a 4.0 scale or for applicants who have an ACT composite		
22	$\underline{\text{superscore}}$ or $\underline{\text{ACT}}$ equivalent score greater than nineteen (19).		
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
