8 AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES  
9 AND OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKS,  
10 HERITAGE, AND TOURISM - CAPITOL ZONING DISTRICT  
11 COMMISSION FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2022;  
12 AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

15 AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKS,  
16 HERITAGE, AND TOURISM - CAPITOL ZONING  
17 DISTRICT COMMISSION APPROPRIATION FOR THE  
18 2021-2022 FISCAL YEAR.

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
23

24 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established  
25 for the Department of Parks, Heritage, and Tourism - Capitol Zoning District  
26 Commission for the 2021-2022 fiscal year, the following maximum number of  
27 regular employees.

1 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Department  
 2 of Parks, Heritage, and Tourism - Capitol Zoning District Commission for the  
 3 2021-2022 fiscal year, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary  
 4 employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated  
 5 herein for such purposes: one (1) temporary or part-time employee, when  
 6 needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform  
 7 Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the  
 8 appropriate classification.

9  
 10 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated,  
 11 to the Department of Parks, Heritage, and Tourism, to be payable from the  
 12 Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account, for personal services and operating  
 13 expenses of the Department of Parks, Heritage, and Tourism - Capitol Zoning  
 14 District Commission for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022, the following:

 29 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - CASH FUND OPERATIONS. There is hereby  
 30 appropriated, to the Department of Parks, Heritage, and Tourism - Capitol  
 31 Zoning District Commission, to be payable from the cash fund deposited in the  
 32 State Treasury as determined by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, for  
 33 operating expenses of the Department of Parks, Heritage, and Tourism -  
 34 Capitol Zoning District Commission for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022,  
 35 the following:

11 SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
 12 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
 13 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
 14 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
 15 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
 16 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
 17 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
 18 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
 19 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

21 SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
 22 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
 23 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
 24 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
 25 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
 26 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
 27 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
 28 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

30 SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
 31 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
 32 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the  
 33 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2021 is essential to the operation of  
 34 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
 35 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the  
 36 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2021 could work irreparable harm

upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2021.
