SECTION 20. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

- 1 BUDGET ALLOCATION. Prior to July 1 of each fiscal year, the Legislative
- 2 Council or the Joint Budget Committee shall review the Division of Arkansas
- State Parks and Tourism Department's plan for the upcoming year of amounts to 3
- 4 be disbursed for each park or other entity from the funds appropriated for
