1 BUDGET ALLOCATION. Prior to July 1 of each fiscal year, the Legislative 2 Council or the Joint Budget Committee shall review the Division of Arkansas State Parks and Tourism Department's plan for the upcoming year of amounts to 3 4 be disbursed for each park or other entity from the funds appropriated for 5 State Operations of this Act. The request for review from the agency shall 6 include amounts to be disbursed for each entity for the upcoming fiscal year 7 compared to the current fiscal year's anticipated expenditures and the 8 previous fiscal year's actual expenditures with any additional detail as may 9 be required by the reviewing body. The Division of Arkansas State Parks and 10 Tourism Department shall also prepare a semiannual status report for the 11 reviewing body comparing six-month and fiscal year actual expenditures to 12 intended disbursements reviewed under this Section.

13 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2020 14 <u>2021</u> through June 30, <del>2021</del> <u>2022</u>.

16 SECTION 21. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 17 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SPECIAL 18 MAINTENANCE. The funds appropriated in the Conservation Tax Appropriation 19 Section of this Act for the Division of Arkansas State Parks and Tourism 20 Special Maintenance shall be expended, after receiving prior approval by the 21 Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, for a special 22 maintenance program for the Park System. The funds provided will be used for 23 repair and upkeep of parks and museum facilities that have been deferred due 24 to lack of funds in the individual budgets of the parks and museums.

25 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of 26 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year 27 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by 28 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and 29 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by 30 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly 31 has determined that the Department of Division of Arkansas State Parks and 32 Tourism may operate more efficiently if some flexibility is provided to the 33 Department of Parks, Heritage and Tourism authorizing broad powers under this 34 Section. Therefore, it is both necessary and appropriate that the General 35 Assembly maintain oversight by requiring prior approval of the Legislative 36 Council or Joint Budget Committee as provided by this section. 15 SECTION 25. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 16 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TOURISM 17 ATTRACTION FEASIBILITY GRANT PROGRAM. Of the funds appropriated to the 18 Department of Parks, Heritage and Tourism for Tourism/Museum grants in the 19 State Operations Appropriation Section of this Act, the Department is 20 authorized to make grants to cities and counties on a one to one dollar 21 matching basis, up to \$15,000 in state funds per grant, for the purpose of 22 feasibility studies for tourism attractions. The Department is authorized to 23 promulgate rules and regulations for the administration of this tourism 24 attraction feasibility grant program. The Department of Parks, Heritage and 25 Tourism shall notify House and Senate Legislators representing the district 26 of the award recipient.

The Department of Parks<u>, Heritage</u> and Tourism is hereby authorized 33 to enter into contracts with Department employees for the provision of golf 34 lessons at the Department's golf courses, outside of the employees' normal 35 working hours. Employees shall be Class A members and/or apprentices of the 36 Professional Golfers' Association of America or the Ladies Professional Golf

The General Assembly acknowledges the economic benefits of 11 festivals which attract visitors and stimulate the growth of tourism and 12 businesses statewide.

13 Notwithstanding any other provision of law or rules and regulations 14 promulgated by the Department of Parks, <u>Heritage</u> and Tourism to the contrary, 15 the Department of Parks, <u>Heritage</u> and Tourism shall dedicate, commit and 16 budget annually one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) from the 2% 17 tourism tax credited to the Tourism Development Trust Fund for expense, 18 advertising, marketing or grants for small festivals in Arkansas communities 19 of less than 10,500 people. Any funds not granted out in a fiscal year shall 20 be available for other tourism promotion efforts.

The War Memorial Stadium Commission Department of Parks, Heritage and 27 Tourism may utilize their authorized extra-help positions and contract labor 28 event staff up to a maximum of one thousand eight hundred (1,800) hours during seasonal events at War Memorial Stadium. The rates of pay may not 29 30 exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification Act, or its successor, 31 for the appropriate classification.

35 SECTION 29. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds

9 SECTION 30. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 10 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 11 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 12 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 13 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 14 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 15 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 16 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 17

18 SECTION 31. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the 19 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits 20 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2021 is essential to the operation of 21 22 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 23 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2021 could work irreparable harm 24 25 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental 26 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act 27 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2021. 28 29 30 31 */s/Joint Budget Committee* 32
