17 (a)(1)(A) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State may create paying 18 accounts on his or her books and on the books of the Treasurer of the State 19 and Auditor of State for the payment of all personal services and operating 20 expenses of the Department of Agriculture.

(B) Upon prior approval of the Arkansas Legislative Council, or if meeting in Legislative Session the Joint Budget Committee, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the state shall direct the transfer of funds and appropriations to the Shared Services Paying Account appropriation section of this act and the transfer of positions to the Regular Salaries - Shared Services appropriation section of this act on the books of the Treasurer of State, the Auditor of State, and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State.

(2) The transfer authority provided in subdivision (a)(1) of this
section for efficiencies and to eliminate duplication of services are limited
only to those services that are provided for multiple divisions of a
department, including without limitation to administration, human resources,
procurement, communications, fleet operations, and information services.

(3) The transfer authority provided to the department in subdivision
(a)(1) of this section may be used to make transfers only within the
department's appropriation act or between other appropriation acts authorized
for the department.

(b)(1) Each department utilizing the Shared Services Paying Account
section or Regular Salaries - Shared Services section of this act shall
submit a report to be included in the Budget Manuals for hearings, conducted
by the General Assembly, listing all shared services transfers of positions,
funds, and appropriation under this section, which shall be submitted as
instructed by the Department of Finance and Administration - Office of Budget
for uniformity.

8 (2) A report submitted under subdivision (b)(1) of this section9 shall include the following:

10 (A) The position number, authorized position title, class
11 code, grade, business area, and name of the division, section, or unit for
12 the position being transferred to the Regular Salaries - Shared Services
13 section of this act; and

(B) The fund center, appropriation, appropriation amount,
commitment item or items, business area, and name of the division, section,
or unit for the fund or appropriation being transferred to the Shared
Services Paying Account.

18 (c)(1) It is the intent of the Ninety-Second General Assembly that the 19 authority under this section to transfer positions is intended for use for the 20 time period prior to Fiscal Year 2022 2023 to allow cabinet-level departments 21 to establish a centralized Regular Salaries - Shared Services section, with 22 the recommendation that the position transfer authority granted under this 23 section be discontinued after that time.

(2) The Bureau of Legislative Research shall bring the
recommendation in subdivision (c)(1) of this section to the attention of the
chairs conducting the 2021 2022 Regular Fiscal Session pre-session budget
hearings, the chairs of the Special Language Subcommittee, and the members of
the Special Language Subcommittee during pre-session budget hearings.

29 (d) Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount 30 of appropriation and general revenue funding for a cabinet-level department 31 each fiscal year is the prerogative of the General Assembly and is usually 32 accomplished by delineating the maximums in the appropriation act or acts and 33 establishing authorized positions and the general revenue allocations 34 authorized for each fund and fund account by amendment to the Revenue 35 Stabilization Law. Further, the General Assembly has determined that the 36 cabinet-level departments created under Acts 2019, No. 910, may operate more

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1 efficiently if some flexibility is provided as authorized under this section. 2 Therefore, it is both necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly 3 maintain oversight by requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or, 4 if the General Assembly is in session, the Joint Budget Committee, as 5 provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative 6 Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section. 7 If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget 8 Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, 9 this entire section is void.

10 (e) The provisions of this section shall be in effect from the date of 11 passage through June 30, 2021 <u>2022</u>.

SECTION 34. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 13 14 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND 15 TRANSFER. The Deputy Director of the Livestock and Poultry Commission, with 16 prior approval of the Arkansas Legislative Council or the Joint Budget 17 Committee, the approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, and for the 18 reimbursing of documented expenditures designated by law to be made from the 19 transferred special revenue, may transfer funds among the Livestock and 20 Poultry Equine Infectious Anemia Control Fund, Livestock and Poultry 21 Commission Disease and Pest Control Fund, Livestock and Poultry Special 22 Revenue Fund, Livestock and Poultry Commission Swine Testing Fund, and the 23 Poultry and Egg Grading Fund or from these funds to the Livestock and Poultry 24 Fund Account. The purpose of these transfers shall only be for accurate 25 allocation of incurred costs between the funds. Requests for fund transfer 26 will at least include the total amount to be transferred, to and from which 27 funds, the nature, purpose, and time period of the expenditures being 28 reimbursed, and any other information requested by the Legislative Council or 29 the Joint Budget Committee.

Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly has determined that the Arkansas Agriculture Department - Livestock and

If the State Plant Board determines that the 17 demands of pest eradication efforts require additional personnel expenses, 18 with the approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and approval by 19 the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, appropriations may be 20 transferred from the Pest Eradication Program special line item to the line 21 items for Regular Salaries, Extra Help, Overtime, and Personal Services 22 Matching.

23 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of 24 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year 25 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by 26 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and 27 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by 28 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly 29 has determined that the State Plant Board may operate more efficiently if 30 some flexibility is provided to the State Plant Board authorizing broad 31 powers under this Section. Therefore, it is both necessary and appropriate 32 that the General Assembly maintain oversight by requiring prior approval of 33 the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee as provided by this 34 section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint 35 Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section. If the requirement 36 of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is ruled

1 unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, this entire section is 2 void.

3 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2020

6 SECTION 36. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 7 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER 8 PROVISION. If the State Forestry Commission determines that temporary 9 firefighters, dispatchers, or pilots are required to meet the demands of a 10 wildfire season, and upon approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, 11 appropriations may be transferred from either Extra Help or Professional Fees 12 and Services to the proper character code for the employment of such 13 personnel.

14 If the State Forestry Commission determines that the deployment of air 15 tankers for fighting wildfires requires additional Professional Fees and 16 Services, and upon the approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, 17 excess appropriation in Regular Salaries or Personal Services Matching may be 18 transferred to Professional Fees and Services in the Operations and Forestry 19 - Rural Community Fire Protection - Federal appropriation sections. 20 If the State Forestry Commission determines that the most effective way for 21 it to cooperate in the growing and distribution of forest planting stock is 22 by contracting work with private vendors and/or hiring temporary employees 23 for seasonal work, the Commission is hereby authorized, upon approval by the 24 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, to transfer the necessary appropriation 25 authorized for Extra Help and Maintenance and General Operation in the 26 Operations and Forestry - Rural Community Fire Protection - Federal 27 appropriation sections.

28 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, $\frac{2020}{2021}$ through June 30, $\frac{2021}{2022}$.

31 SECTION 37. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 32 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. REFUND TO 33 EXPENDITURE. The Arkansas Forestry Commission is authorized to charge fees 34 to federal agencies and other states to reimburse the Commission for 35 expenditures made on behalf of these governmental units. These fees shall be 36 deposited into the State Forestry Fund in the State Treasury as a refund to

l expenditure.

2 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2020

SECTION 38. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 5 6 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. PROMOTIONAL ITEMS. The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall establish 7 8 upon request for the Arkansas Agriculture Department a special Promotional 9 Items appropriation to be used in the acquisition of promotional items. 10 When the Arkansas Agriculture Department wishes to transfer from its 11 operating expenses to the promotional items line, the request shall be 12 forwarded by the Arkansas Agriculture Department to the Chief Fiscal Officer 13 of the State for processing and for prior approval by the Arkansas 14 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee. Determining the maximum 15 number of employees and the maximum amount of appropriation and general 16 revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year is the prerogative of the 17 General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by delineating such maximums 18 in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and the general revenue 19 allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by amendment to the 20 Revenue Stabilization law. It is the intent of the General 7 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 8 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 9 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 10 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 11 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 12 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 13 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 14

15 SECTION 43. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the 16 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits 17 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2021 is essential to the operation of 18 19 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 20 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2021 could work irreparable harm 21 22 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental 23 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act 24 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health 25 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2021. 26 27 28 29 30 31 32 33 34 35
